

Special Select Board Meeting
Meeting with NVDA
On Hydrologically Connected Road Segments
September 13, 2017

Attendance: Tim Simpson (chair Select Board), Scott Spencer (Select Board), Doug Morton (NVDA), Rick Jackson (Road Foreman), Dan Jackson (Road Crew)

Tim opened the meeting at 10:04 am

Doug started by giving a brief description of the “Grants & Aide Pilot money”. The importance of prioritizing roads based on ditching, removal of shoulders and replacing culverts.

Doug’s role is to inventory the roads based on the crown, grader windrows, ditching. This is done annually.

Each road “segment” is 100 meters. The full “segment” needs to be brought up to code before he can pass it. You can do more than one segment at a time. If there are places you want added, he can add “segments” to our town map.

The total for this project is \$6360. The total the State awarded the Town of Sutton is \$5300 with an in-kind match from the town of \$1060.

The roads discussed to look at were Sheffield/ Woodhill Rd and Sargents Rd.

Doug, Rick and Dan agreed to go look at these roads.

Scott moved to close the meeting at 10:38. Tim seconded this motion.
