Critique the information received from the public meeting-

The committee is going to continue working with landowners to get trails on their private property, to connect to town roads that are opened by the Select Board.

We need the "Sign Package" from NVDA for the State Aid Highways (Class 2) before the committee can proceed. Roads need to be legally posted for vehicles and in compliance with the current speed ordinance.
