

Sutton Planning Commission
Minutes of special meeting 8-28-2018
Sutton town offices, 6:00 P.M.

In attendance: Paul Brouha, Hank Parker, Chip Devenger, Lucien Belanger, Darlene Ahrens (PC), Brandon Mazur (clerk), Alison Low (NVDA)

The meeting was called to order at 6:05 P.M.

Alison was welcomed to the meeting.

There were no additions or deletions to the proposed agenda.

Brandon read the minutes of the special PC meeting on 8-14-18. Chip moved to accept the minutes. Lucien seconded. The minutes were accepted without correction.

The meeting then moved on to old business. Alison joined the Planning Commission in discussing the initial draft of a revised Sutton Town Plan. Alison presented copies of the draft as originally revised and with some additions she recommends. All were accepting of the changes. Members of the PC volunteered to proofread a section they were not the writer of: Lucien "History of Sutton," "Housing Element," Hank "Land Use Plan," "Educational Facilities Plan," "Adjacent Towns," Chip "Utility and Facility Plan," Darlene "Energy Plan," "Transportation Plan," Paul "Introduction and Overview," "Preservation Plan," "Economic Development." The PC decided to convene again on 9-11-18 for a special meeting. The target date for the public hearing on the draft's adoption is October 16, 2018.

Next, Paul presented to the PC a letter to the Select Board he drafted regarding the evolving debate over allowing ATV use on Sutton's Class 3 and 4 roads. No action was taken at the most recent Select Board meeting. A discussion followed about finding compromise with petitioners.

Chip moved to adjourn. Hank seconded. The meeting adjourned at 7:27 P.M.
