

Sutton Planning Commission
Minutes of meeting 3-26-19
6:00 P.M., Sutton Town Office

In attendance: Lucien Belanger, Hank Parker, Darlene Ahrens [Sutton PC], Brandon Mazur, Martha Tack

The meeting was called to order at 6:12 by Hank, who agreed to facilitate the meeting in Paul's absence. There were no additions/deletions to proposed agenda.

Brandon read the draft minutes of the last PC meeting, on 2-26-2019. Darlene moved to accept the minutes as read. Hank seconded. After a vote, the minutes were accepted.

Old Business:

Martha presented a summary of the results of the 2002 Town Planning Committee Survey. The Planning Commission thanks her for her volunteer efforts to gather this information, which is of great assistance to the PC.

Hank offered copies of the Westfield survey, Craftsbury survey, and Burke survey in addition to the 2002 Sutton Town Survey. Hank asked which format the PC thinks we should use? Discussion ensued about the form and content of the various surveys. Hank noted that Joe Solinsky suggested a question about ATVs be included. The PC's sense is that the ATV Committee is doing a great job of soliciting input from residents.

The PC thought that the general format of the Westfield survey would work best and that Darlene offered to prepare a draft of the new Sutton survey based on comments and suggestions of the PC. The group reviewed the Westfield Community Survey question by question and discussed the merits of including or excluding each question, stopping at question number 21.

New Business:

Darlene and Martha shared the results of the 3-20-19 NVDA Energy Seminar saying it was helpful because they learned about supports available to the Committee, savings and grants available, and offerings from Window Dressers of Rockland, ME and NETO.

Current Sutton Energy Committee members are Byron, Rich, Martha, Chip, and Dana Patoine.
