The minutes from October,20, 2020 were read and accepted as read.

Reports on weatherization of the town office building:

1. LED bulbs to replace florescent bulbs- Maurice

LED bulbs can be put in older florescent fixtures. Cost is 2 for \$8.88 but less if they are purchased in bulk (10 packs). There is also a retro kit that can be used with some bulbs but is not necessary for all types. One just needs to be sure they are buying the correct LED bulbs. Maurice will let us know at the next meeting how many would need to be replaced to do the whole building.

2. Boilers/furnaces - Dana

There are two in the garage. One is a waste oil furnace. Both have maintenance contracts. He will check to see if there is a third for the office.

3. Thermostat - Mary

4. Assessment of what changes have been made in response to the 2011 energy audit.

Darlene sent an email to the town clerk to determine what had been done and what our fuel consumption was last winter. This will be used to help construct our energy use dashboard.

Update on Window Dressers

Laura of WD remains guarded optimistic that we the program will be able to move forward in the fall. It depends on the status of the Covid pandemic as community involvement is a key component of the program. We will proceed with that in mind.

Change of meeting times due to conflict with other town meetings:
